INTENSIVE TRAINING OF ATHLETES, COACHES, ASSISTANT COACHES AND CHAPERONS

- In line with the preparation for the 2020 Central Luzon Regional Athletic Association (CLRAA) Meet, this Office announces the In-house Intensive Training of Athletes, Coaches, Assistant Coaches and Chaperons on March 10-19, 2020.
- 2. The activity primarily aims to strengthen the physical, mental and emotional well-being of the athletes and coaches who will compete in the said competition.
- 3. Athletes, Coaches, Assistant Coaches and Chaperons are expected to be on the training venue during the conduct of the intensive training.
- 4. Medical teams are assigned to be on the different training venues to ensure the health condition of the participants.
- 5. Participants to this training are expected to bring their beddings, toiletries and other personal belongings needed for the training.
- 6. School heads shall make necessary arrangement to avoid disruption of classes in lieu of the teachers who will join the intensive training. An intervention shall be given also to the athletes to cover their absences from their classes. Refer to **Regional Memorandum No. 13, s. 2000 entitled "Rating of School Athletes"**. Likewise, the school head of the concerned schools as host of the intensive training shall ensure the safety and convenience of the athletes, coaches, assistant coaches and chaperons who will stay in the respective training venues.

REGIONAL MEMORANDUM NO. 13, S. 2000

RATING SCHOOL ATHLETES

TO: Schools Division Superintendents
Vocational Schools Superintendents/ Administrators
President of State Colleges/ Universities
Heads of Private Schools/ Colleges/ Universities

 All concerned are hereby enjoined to comply strictly with the mandates of Education Act of 1982 Rule III, Section 3 (e) that teachers shall:

> " refrain from making deductions in the scholastic rating of pupils or students, for any act that is clearly not a manifestation of poor scholarship".

- On the same basis, teachers or any other school officials threatening their pupils or students by indiscriminately deducting or refusing to give them grades/ ratings while at the same time allowing them to participate in sports competitions shall be held responsible.
- 3. Special assistance should be given to pupils/ students who are representing their schools during sports competitions by giving them advanced lessons, special tests, self-learning modules, and the like to help them catch up with their lessons.
- Being representatives of their respective schools, districts, school divisions, these pupils/ students deserve special assistance and other incentives in the form of awards, materials or financial assistance, and others.
- To forestall conflicts between school and community it serves, it is advised that athletes be selected not only on the basis of their athletic prowess but also taking into consideration their ability to catch up with missed lessons. Athletes with below average academic performance should no longer be selected for higher level sports competition.

6. This Regional Memorandum is authored to encourage potential pupils/ students-athletes to become part of this Department's objective in line with the national goal of the government as provided for under Section 19, Article XIV of the 1987 Philippine Constitution.

the state shall promote physical education and encourage sports programs, league competitions, and amateur sports, including training for international competitions, to fower self discipline, team work and excellence for the development of a healthy and alert citizenry. All educational institutions shall undertake regular sports activities throughout the country in cooperation with athletic clubs and other sectors.
