With reference to the letter dated March 6, 2020 of Maria Teresa Macanas Semana, PhD, CESO IV, Officer-in-Charge, Office of the Director IV, Commission on Higher Education Regional Office III (CHEDRO III), all DepEd Region III officers and employees are hereby informed that FAR EAST ADVENT SCHOOL OF THEOLOGY INTERNATIONAL (FEAST), INC., is a noninstitution government. non-sectarian educational that ecclesiastical programs, and non-secular degrees/programs, hence, it is not authorized by CHEDROIII to offer graduate or post graduate programs.

Moreover, FEAST is not in the list of recognized HEIs in the Region and neither did it apply for tertiary and post graduate programs in CHEDROIII.

In this connection, since it is stipulated in the institution's Amended Articles of Incorporation filed at the Securities and Exchange Commission that, it is a non-government, non-sectarian educational institution that offers ecclesiastical programs, and non secular degrees/programs", hence the institution is not authorized by this Office to offer graduate or post graduate programs. Further, the said Far East Advent School of Theology international, Inc., is not in the list of recognized HEIs in the Region and neither it applied for tertiary and post graduate programs in this Office.
