HISTORY OF THE FOUNDATION OF LICAONG ELEMENTARY SCHOOL

Licaong Elementary School located approximately 9 kilometers away from the Marcos Highway, it is located at North side of Science City of Muňoz. Nearby barangay Magtanggol where located in Southwest.

The school was started as primary only with one building formerly name was Buenaventura primary School because of that level small population was existed only one teacher was assigned there and was teaching a combination level (Grade I-II) only one teacher assigned in the primary school namely: Tessie Lumitap, Lorie Cansino, Mr. Aquino, and Lotes V. Reyes under the management of Mr. Leonardo G. Roa because it was satellite school of Magtanggol Elementary School during 1997-2001.

In the year 2002, it was relocated into its new site school has size of lot almost 5,000 square meters purchased by the former City Mayor Efren L. Alvarez the budget was from the local fund wherein it was composed of three classrooms. At that time there were only two teachers: one had permanent position and other one teacher from Local School Board they are Lotes V. Reyes, Elsa Dela Cruz Through the years, pupils 'population officially enrolled were increased so there was an additional teachers, Leoval Dela Cruz, Mary Jane Ramirez and consistent satellite of Magtanggol Elementary School under the supervision of Mrs. Emily I. Fernandez.

In the year 2006 onwards, Licaong elementary School became a complete Elementary School, with a total enrolment of one hundred forty three (143). The first commencement Exercises was occurred during the supervision of Mr. Ronnie B. Rimando who was the foremost principal when completed school was established, teachers are: Lotes V. Reyes, MaryJane Ramirez, Arlene M. Agustin, Natividad I. Niegos, Sheryl Ann A. Cinense then

Mrs. Joseline G. Andrada was the first adviser of Grade Six pupils who were

the first graduating pupil and also the added the Kindergarten teacher, Eloisa

M. Manabat. The development of school pursued through the cooperation and

effort of principal Parents teachers Association, stakeholders LGU, Dep Ed.

In the year 2012, the school improvement rapidly grow under the

management of Mr. Manuel U. Fernandez, it had three school buildings, it

consisted of eight classrooms with own concrete and with tiles lavatory with

cabinet below it and had a new electric pump to supply water entire building,

multi-purpose gym, kindergarten building, principal's office with tiles on the

floor, canteen facility and constructed permanent perimeter fence around the

school funded from MOOE, PTA, Stakeholders, LGU.

In the year 2017, Sir Ronnie Rimando came back to the school as

School head up to this present that he was retired. Finally the current

teachers of this school are the following: Lotes V. Reyes, Arlene M. Agustin,

Natividad I. Niegos, Sheryl Ann A. Cinense, Eloisa M. Manabat, Tessie A.
