BRIEF HISTORY

The **Little Lamb Foundational Learning Center (now Little Lamb FLC in Muñoz Inc.)** was conceived in 1993 in response to a call of providing quality educational foundation for the children of **Jesus Christ the Living God Fellowship (JCLGF)** members, friends, and residents of the Science City of Muñoz. The term **“Little Lamb”** was coined by the Board of Trustees in 1995 and **“Foundational Learning Center”** was derived from the **Institute for Foundational Learning Center** where the pre-school is affiliated with.

The Institute for Foundational Learning Center is a division of Somer Haven International Ministries Foundation, a duly registered domestic corporation with its main office located in Cabuyao, Laguna. The school curriculum enhances the child’s capabilities such as his creative way of learning practical skills, and develops his initiative and analytical thinking. It also provides Christian Education as a better way of attaining academic excellence in the learning process.

The school is guided by the Scriptures found in Proverbs 22:6 **“Train up a child in the way he should go, and when he is old, he will not depart from it.”** Therefore, the character you want to have your child **TOMORROW** depends on the values you put in his heart **TODAY**.

A. VISION STATEMENT

The Little Lamb FLC as a model school of learning in the pre-elementary and elementary levels in terms of its program, curricula, facilities and manpower resources.

B. MISSION STATEMENT

Produce pupils who are competent and adequately enroll in the pre-elementary and elementary education.
