Brief History of MNHS-Annex

To address the imbalance in the number of individuals who should have access to basic education, and establish 0% illiteracy in the Science City of Munoz, the Munoz National High School Annex was established on July 10, 2007 on a 10- hectare lot located at the core of Barangay Rizal, Science City of Munoz thr ough LOGOFIND financing.

The construction of the Annex was spearheaded by the municipal engineering office during the incumbency of the then municipal mayor, Efren L. Alvarez, Ph.D. Upon submission of the documentary requirements and adherence to standard operating procedures of LOGOFIND, the proposed construction of the Annex was approved on October 23, 2001.

Feasibility study to ensure success was conducted on December 3-6, 2001. This was immediately followed by submission of documents including the Sangguniang Panlungsod Resolution number 30, series 2004 stating the interest of the city to construct school building composition of Local Finance Committee and the composition of Management Office.

On August 10-12, 2004, the funding agency, LOGOFIND, composed of an economist engineer and environmental scientist, finalized the cost estimates and drafted the economic and financial analyses and environmental appraisal of the proposed MNHS ANNEX building

The creation of Project Management Office, the powerhouse or

The creation of Project Management Office, the powerhouse or workforce, then materialized with the chief local executive Hon. Nestor L. Alvarez, Ph.D. as its chair, Engr. Armando E. Miranda as coordinator, Engr. Arnel M. Ruz as manager and Engineers Rogato H. Mingala, Randy G. Baldedara and Edwin S. Saliganan as members.

With these determined people overseeing the project land conversion through the Department of Agrarian Reform was granted on January 12, 2004.

Having conditionally approved during the first presentation to the Policy Governing Board on February 10, 2005, the project pushed through and was given full approval on May 19, 2005 with financial scheme of 50% grant, 35% sub loan, and 15 % equity from LOGOFIND.

Completion of the project design was made possible by close consultation with the funding agency, close monitoring of the engineering staff and unparalleled dedication of the personnel who worked night and day to complete the DED.

Armed with the approved DED, bidding came next. After the adherence to standard operating procedures, procurement found its way.

The uneven terrain which was impassable, unpredictable weather conditions, workmanship and compliance to specifications hindered the completion of the project within the target date. But the wait was all worth it as the two-storey building of the MNHS ANNEX was erected and completed with the home economic building, industrial arts building and drainage system ready for use on July 10, 2007 and finally turned over the Science City of Muñoz on July 14, 2008.

Bounded on the north and east by agriculture land, on the south by barangay road and on the west by a body of water, the school hones holistic individuals who will soon find their niches under the sun.

Being home to young and dreamy individuals whose potentials are yet to be tapped and maximized, the school takes pride in its smooth operations and upkeep, albeit constraints of workforce, budgetary considerations and terrain location.

The Muñoz National High School-Annex as a support system has been and will always be contributing to the image building of the Science City of Muñoz. It vows to continue its ultimate mission of providing literacy and culture of relevant secondary education in this part of the city in particular and in this part of the country in general.

The school is now offering Senior High School which was started last School Year 2016-2017. The school offers HUMSS in Academic track and SMAW, ICT and HE in Tech-Voc Track. In 2018, the Senior High School has approved application to offer additional tracks, the Accountancy Business Management (ABM) and TVL-Agri-Fishery Arts (AFA).

The past leaders of MNHS-Annex are Dr. Joven P. La Rosa (OIC, EPS I), Mrs. Isabelita C. Dagdag (School Principal I), Dr. Elenita R. Romagosa (School Principal IV) and presently it was Mrs. Norma R. Framo (Secondary School Principal IV) who leading the school to address the needs of the learners in the midst of pandemic.

The institution is now in the process of applying for the renaming of the school; change is coming for the better.
