Brief History of MNHS-Main JHS

The Muñoz Provincial High School was established on September 3, 1994. This secondary public school adopted a two pronged objective: to protect the young boys and girls from Japanese oppression and atrocities and to continue the education of these boys and girls that had been interrupted by the war. The founding father was late Mayor Anastacio Tobias supported by civic spirited citizens of the municipality.

There were two sections at the start one for the first year and another for the second year. The pioneers were the mixture of very young students who did not pursue their schooling because of the war, and others who wanted to avail of the high school education. Before the outbreak of the World War II, the high school students had to go to Cabanatuan City for their public high school education. During the war years, the Muñoz Provincial School made possible affordable and accessible high school education.

The Ruiz residence situated on the corner of now Tobias and Bayuga streets served as the first school house. With the carpet bombing of the municipality by the American, the school building was razed to the ground.

Soon after the war, the MPNHS re-opened in the warehouse of Mayor Tobias in Bantug. Classes for third and fourth year students were created. Soon the school moved to Laguna residence in Lumang Bayan where the school had its first organ, THE CHANDELIER. There, too, the first commencement exercises were held in 1946 with 30 graduates.

In 1951, MPNHS was transferred to its permanent site of 8.5 hectares from donation of four philanthropic families of Bustos and Martin, who were cognizant that an education institution should have a home of its own in serving the youth and the nation.

Since then, the school had gained tremendous strides. Its sixty one years of existence witnessed the students ascent of the school to its present status and stature. The year 1982 was a historic one for MPNHS for its was in this year that it became nationalized, hence the MUÑOZ NATIONAL HIGH SCHOOL.
