

HISTORY OF Rizal ELEMENTARY SCHOOL

Rizal Elementary School started from a quaint cogon shanty in 1924 with one teacher. Due to the burning of the school house in 1932 the school was inevitably closed and classes were resumed in 1934 when 2 buildings was constructed. During Japanese time due to chaotic period lawlessness, Muñoz District was centralized in the Poblacion and Rizal Primary School had to close its doors.

Upon the reopening of the school in 1951, Rizal became complete elementary school. It is situated six kilometers away from city proper and bounded by Barangay San Felipe in the North, Barangay Linglingay in the West, Barangay Franza in the South and Barangay Cabisuculan in the East. At this time, it is a home and place of learning to pupils coming from Cabisuculan, Franza, San Felipe and San Andres.

The school aims to empower the learners to be leaders and capable of self - adjustment in life.

Rizal Elementary has a land area of 8,448 sq. meters and headed by assigned school heads.
