History of San Andres Elementary School

The school was established in 1954 as Primary School and as satellite of Rizal Elementary School for several years.

In 1965, one building with three classrooms were constructed. This was the very first building in the school and it was named as Marcos Building. The building was used as combination classroom for Grades 1 and 2, the other one was for Grades 3 and 4 and the remaining one was served as office.

In 2000, the school was granted FVR building with two classrooms. It paved the way for the school to be complete. Since then the school named San Andres Elementary School. A Teacher In-Charge (TIC) was assigned to direct the school with seven teachers.

From three classrooms to now ten classrooms, the school continuously grows to cater the children of barangay. A full time Principal-I leads the school. There are eight eligible and dedicated teachers distributed in Kindergarten to Grade 6. Among teachers, there are four who are Teacher I, three are Teacher III and one who is a Master Teacher I.
