HISTORY OF SAPANG CAWAYAN ELEMENTARY SCHOOL

The school of Brgy. Sapang Cawayan was constructed in the year 1960. It started as a primary school in the District of Munoz under the Division of Nueva Ecija. It is located at the center of the barangay and situated in the eastern part of the town of Munoz. The land area of the school site is three thousand three hundred forty one square meters (3,341 sq.m) which is donated through the kindness of Mrs. Josefina Valdez Balmeo. Ms. Guadalupe Grospe Baltazar was the first teacher assigned to hold a combination class of Grade I and II.

In 1990, the school became complete elementary and was headed by Mrs. Eleanor R. Landingin. She acted as Teacher-In – charge of the school from 1990 until 1998. It was during her administration that the school got well known not only in the district but also in the division because of the Clean and Green Projects. In 1998, when Mrs. Eleanor Landingin got promoted, Mrs. Rosa Jumaquio took over her place. She served the school for one year and she was able to maintain the physical aspect of it.

In 1999, Mr. Reynaldo Dela Cruz replaced Mrs. Jumaquio as Teacher Incharge. In his administration he launched many projects that improved the physical aspects of the school, thus he got promoted to Head Teacher III. His term lasted for seven years and Mr. Pepito D. De Guzman took his place as the Teacher In-charge in June 2006. One of his priorities is the achievement rate of pupils. He was able to improve the school performance on the National Achievement Test. He also raised many projects like Math and Science Garden, landscaping, nursery and additional for classroom school building through the City Mayor. Because of his dedication to his work Mr. De Guzman got promoted to Head Teacher III.

In 2014, Mr. Ricardo Medrano, Head Teacher III, was the next school head for almost four years. In his time, he was able to lift the school's

performance which made SCES ranked 1 for 2 consecutive years. Through his effort, the Gabaldon building was demolished.

In 2016, Mr. Ricardo Medrano was transferred to San Felipe Elementary School, and Ma'am Winnie W. Poli was assigned as the OIC for two months from July to September, then Mr. Augusto A. Mateo assigned as OIC for the month of October to December 2016.

Mrs. Divina M. Capinpin managed the school from 2017 to January, 2021. During her time, The Garcia type building was demolished and replaced by one building with three classrooms.

After the management of Mrs. Capinpin, the school now is under the leadership of Dr. Madelyn D. Ilagan, a Principal II. She is still new to the school but has shown enthusiasm in her administration.

For programs and other activities, the school has a stage and a multi-purpose gymnasium which was also built school year 2010-2011 thru the kindness of Congressman Joseph Gilbert Violago. The school also has 9 classrooms and a principals' office with eight (8) permanent teachers.
