#### HISTORY OF VILLA CUIZON ELEMENTARY SCHOOL

The school of Brgy. Villa Cuizon is located 4.5 kilometers away from the city and is accessible to all means of transportation. Year 2013,Dr. Ruben C. Sevilleja, President of Central Luzon State University (CLSU) and Department of Education, Division of City Schools represented by Mr. Ronnie B. Rimando signed Memorandum of Agreement that the parcel of land located at Villa Cuizon, Science City of Munoz containing a total lot area of 11,369.83sq.m. 2,327.30 sq.m of the said lot is for school use and is renewable every 10 years from the year thereof.

It started as a primary school in 1960 with a combination class of Grades 1 and 2 under Mrs. Constantino as their teacher. The lot where the primary school is located is donated by the Cuizon Family. Villa Cuizon was then a Sitio of Sapang Cauayan until the year 1992 where it became the newest barangay in Munoz, Nueva Ecija through the effort of Peter Fajad Jimenez, thus Villa Cuizon Primary School was born. It was year 2002 when the new school building for Villa Cuizon Primary School was built on the lot of CLSU. It was a 2-classroom building.

School Year 2006-2007, the school became complete elementary headed by Mr. Jhon F. del Mundo as Teacher-in-Charge (TIC) and Mrs. Angelica M. Burayag as Grade 6 Class Adviser and the first graduation ceremony was held in Barangay Villa Cuizon.

In 2007, Mr. Reynaldo Dela Cruz stationed as Head Teacher I of VCES.
In 2008, Mrs. Genalyn B. Enriquez, now Mrs. Genalyn B. Tangonan was designated as the new Head Teacher of the school. She headed the school for 4 years. In her administration, many projects were launched for the

improvement of the school. It was during her term when 1 classroom donated by Cong. Joseph Violago was built. In 2012, Mrs. Genalyn B. Tangonan got promoted as Principal I and was stationed at San Andres Elementary School.

Mr. Ronnie B. Rimando replaced Mrs. Tangonan on 2012, the first principal who headed the school. His term lasted for 5 years and was transferred to Licaong Elemetary School. It was in his term when MOA between CLSU and DepEd was signed for the use of its lot as school facility.

In 2017, VCES became a satellite school of Maragol IS under the administration of Mr. Pepito D. de Guzman. It was during his leadership where he was able to improve the physical aspect of the school. In his term, a 2-classroom DPWH building was built.

2018 when Dr. Madelyn D. Ilagan was assigned as the new principal of the school. It was during her term when the Drum and Lyre Marching Band of Villa Cuizon Elemetary School was established. A school gymnasium was also built during her term. The school gymnasium was built through the effort of Congresswoman Mikaela S. Violago.

Mrs. Divina M. Capinpin then replaced Mrs. Madelyn D. Ilagan as Principal on 2021. She is new in the school and she working heartily for the improvement of the school's physical aspect. She is working with hand in hand with PTA Officers. On a month of her term, she was able to built a 2-door comfort room and a hand washing area.

Mrs. Eden V. Balmelero, Teacher III, is the class adviser of Grade IV which consists of 14 male and 19 female. Mam Eden is the school's coordinator of SBM, SMEA, Mathematics, Testing and Boy Scout.

Grade V class is under the advisory of Mrs. Rowena I. Bernardo. Grade V class has 21 male and 10 female. Mam Weng is the school coordinator for ICT, Brigada Eskwela,. Adopt-a-School, English, Reading, GSP and SPA Adviser.
