History of Villa Isla Elementary School



In the highest part of the Science City of Munoz, Province of Nueva Ecija approximately nine (9) kilometers away from the city proper, the school situates beside the hall and plaza of barangay Villa Isla. The less than one (1) hectare rolling site is surrounded by different kinds of trees that provide fresh air and gives shade that makes the place conducive for learning and recreational activities. Boxes with flowering plants in every classroom, hedges of various pathway and semi terraces stairs are additional attractions in the school. The school perimeter is secured by concrete and steel fences. The main gate and the two other gates at the left and right sides are all made of steel.

In 1968, during the administration of Mayor Dominador V. Santos, two-school buildings were constructed: the Army-type with multipurpose pavement in the plaza and another unit of Santos-Type Building rose in this place. It was then a primary school that caters Grades One to Three levels only then it became an elementary institution with complete grade levels.

The infrastructures in the school compound were constructed in U-shape which include the Violago Building (office) constructed last 2007, the Joson Type (Home Economics Building) in 1992, the three (3) Marcos Type Building in 1968, which is condemnable, two (2) Garcia Type classrooms, an Osmeña Type Building (ICT Room) constructed in 2002 and the Garcia Building which is being used as Grade VI classroom and canteen, and the newly constructed Multi-Purpose School Gymnasium by Governor Aurelio M. Umali. Three more buildings were also built in the compound: DepEd building with 3 classrooms (2011), Violago Building that was constructed in 2012 with 2 classrooms used as Grade I classrooms and the newly constructed building with 6 classrooms between a public-private partnership.

At present, the school has sufficient classrooms for the learners. All rooms are well-ventilated, provided with electricity, comfort rooms, lavatories and water supply.
