- 4. Participants are given 1.5 hours to finish their outputs.
- 5. Outputs must be submitted 3 minutes after the competition to upload in the google drive provided during the competition.
- 6. File name should be in this format: POSTER_SCHOOL (POSTER_RIZAL)
- 7. Student-participant may be accompanied by one coach. However, coaches are only allowed to assist student during the setting up of materials on the day of the competition.
- 8. The medium for visual artistry shall only be limited to oil pastel and shall be provided by the contestant.
- 9. Participants are not allowed to bring pictures or images for reference of their entries.
- 10. The poster must be original. If the submitted poster is found to have been plagiarized, it will be disqualified from the competition.
- 11. The contestants and coaches of the Top 5 winning posters will receive a Certificate of Recognition.

- 2. One (1) student participant per school is allowed.
- 3. Participants must have strong internet connection and must open the camera during the whole duration of the contest.
- 4. Participants are given 1.5 hours to finish their outputs.
- 5. Outputs must be submitted 3 minutes after the competition to upload in the google drive provided during the competition.
- 6. File name should be in this format: ESSAY_SCHOOL_TITLE (ESSAY_MNHS-ANNEX_BATA).
- 7. The essay should have a title.
- 8. Participants shall use A4 size bond paper/s.

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- 9. Entries should be in Filipino, encoded, double-spaced, with a minimum of 1,500 words and maximum of 3,000 words.
- 10. Student-participant may be accompanied by one coach. However, coaches are only allowed to assist student during the setting up of materials on the day of the competition.
- 11. The essay must be original. If the submitted essay is found to have been plagiarized, it will be disqualified from the competition.
- 12. The contestants and coaches of the Top 5 winning essays will receive a Certificate of Recognition.
- 13. The winners will be notified through a Division Memorandum.

- 1. The video essay contest is a short video competition.
- 2. One (1) student participant per school is allowed.
- 3. The video essay should run for a minimum length of 5 minutes and maximum length of 8 minutes.
- 4. The video essay should have a title.
- 5. Videos should be encoded on commonly known video file compressions/formats such as .mp4, .avi, and .mkv.
- 6. Entries must be submitted to this google drive: <u>https://drive.google.com/drive/folders/141q9QnDvL14LqdypnKWNlrttb5GG</u> <u>RfvJ?usp=sharing</u> using the coach's official DepEd email address on or before December 1, 2021, 12:00 noon.
- 7. File name should be in this format: VIDEOESSAY_SCHOOL_TITLE (VIDEOESSAY_MNHS-ANNEX_BATA).
- 8. The video essay must be original. If the submitted video essay is found to have been plagiarized, it will be disqualified from the competition.
