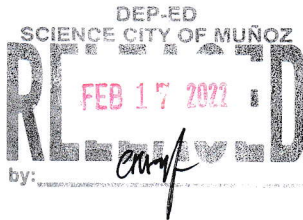

2. All participating schools must ensure coordination with BHERT and LGU for Referral System, Contract Tracing, School Traffic Management, Disinfection, School Lockdown, Vaccination Status, among others.
3. Contingency plan of the participating schools should be readily available. This should reflect the school's response once a COVID case has been detected and will divert to distance learning modality.
4. Moreover, schools should also make sure to have a proactive COVID-19 local hotline/helpdesk that connects and coordinates with hospitals / LGUs.
5. The SDO Composite Team and DFTAT members will conduct their monitoring of all participating ang non-participating schools on February 21, 2022.
