


- 1. Pursuant to the Regional Memorandum No. 227, s.2022 entitled "Quality Assurance of Project All Numerates (PAN) Assessment Tools and Administration of PAN Post-Test", the SDO-Science City of Muñoz announces the conduct of the administration of the PAN Post-Test to all Grade 1 Grade 7 learners on May 23 27, 2022.
- 2. The activity aims to:

a. assess the numeracy level of learners;

- b. analyze test results and update the numeracy profile of learners based on their performance in the PAN post-test; and
- c. craft appropriate interventions that will be implemented from June 6 to the end of SY 2021-2022 and next SY 2022-2023 as part of the Division's Learning Recovery Plan.
- 3. Soft copies of the Project All Numerates (PAN) Post-Test Assessment Tools are already available for downloading in the Shared Google Drive of the Mathematics Coordinators.
- 4. The conduct of the said activity shall be monitored by a designated Regional Monitoring Team on May 27, 2022.
- 5. There will be an online meeting of all Mathematics Coordinators on May 19, 2022 at 9:00 am via MS Teams to discuss the standards of administering the Post-Test and the newly created School Electronic Consolidating Tool for PAN that will facilitate and automate the generation of School PAN reports.
- 6. Immediate and wide dissemination of this Memorandum is enjoined.
