SDO MONITORING OF SCHOOL PHYSICAL PLANT AND FACILITIES

To: Assistant Schools Division Superintendent
Chief Education Supervisors
Public Elementary and Secondary School Heads
All Others Concerned

- 1. In consideration of the well-being of the learners affected by extreme climate conditions as they attend in person classes, this Office reiterates the safety, orderliness, and cleanliness of the schools within the schools division to mitigate the effect of warm weather phenomenon at present.
- 2. As per DepEd Educational Facilities Manual where the primary function of educational facilities is to provide the proper school environment that is most conducive to effective teaching and learning, it is but proper that an appropriate activity be conducted to facilitate the monitoring and appraisal of said educational amenities.
- 3. As such, the Schools Division Office through the School Governance and Operations Division (SGOD) monitor and visit all public schools within the schools division from May 3-5, 2023 to evaluate and assess the following items to ensure school safety, convenience, and favorable conditions of all schools:
 - a. the proportion of classroom viz a viz the number of students and teachers:
 - b. availability of ventilation and cooling equipment inside classroom and offices;
 - c. the condition of classroom walls, ceilings including fixtures, electrical installations and lightings;
 - d. sufficiency of water supplies and implements for fire prevention; and
 - e. observance of waste segregation, upkeep of school surroundings of trash and dried leaves to maintain cleanliness and avoid fire related incidence.
- 4. Enclosure No. 1 contains the composition of the monitoring teams and Enclosure No.2 is the monitoring tool as references.
