SCHOOLS DIVISION TRAINING WORKSHOP ON THE TEACHING STRATEGIES FOR CATCH-UP PROGRAMS IN LITERACY AND NUMERACY

To: Assistant Schools Division Superintendent Chief Education Supervisors Public Elementary Schoolheads All Others Concerned

- 1. In support of the implementation of the Early Language, Literacy, and Numeracy Program (ELLN), this Office, through the Curriculum Implementation Division, shall conduct Schools Division Training Workshop on the Teaching Strategies for Catch-Up Programs in Literacy and Numeracy for Kindergarten to Grades 3 teachers on January 24-26 at Muñoz Central School.
- 2. The training aims to:
 - a. upskill/capacitate K-3 teachers on the teaching strategies to bridge the learning gaps in literacy and numeracy,
 - b. apply developmentally appropriate strategies following the literacy and numeracy level of K to 3 learners,
 - c. deepen their conceptual understanding of context using key strategies in teaching literacy and numeracy across subject areas, and
 - d. promote/sustain a culture of reading in schools and commitment to mentoring/sharing teaching experiences to improve instruction and outcomes.
- 3. The participants in this activity are the untrained Kindergarten to Grade 3 in ELLN.
- 4. Transportation and other incidental expenses shall be charged against school MOOE or other local funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
