

- 1. The Bureau of Learner Support Services-Learner Formation Division (BLSS-LFD) in partnership with the Southeast Asian Ministers of Education Organization Regional Center for Educational Innovation and Technology (SEAMEO INNOTECH) shall conduct a research and development project on Career Development for Children (CD4C): Technical Assistance on Developing Career Guidance Resources for Key Stage 1.

- 3.2 Gather a based line date and profile of public elementary level career guidance implementers;
- 3.3 Provide inputs to the design and implementation of a holistic Career Guidance Program for DepEd's K to 12 key stage; and
- 3.4 Create career guidance teaching and learning resources specifically designed for key stage 1.

The research phase aims to review how elementary-level career guidance implementers provide career guidance activities for key stage 1 learners and to determine the needed teaching and learning resources that career guidance implementers can use to equip key stage 1 learners with age-appropriate career development skills, while the development phase intends to create a career guidance teaching and learning resources specifically design for key stage 1 learners.
