a. Connect academic learning with real-world applications through hands-on activities, industry insights, and career exploration activities;








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- Provide learners with access to mentors, professionals, and role models to develop goal-setting, decision-making, and critical thinking skills;

- Equip learners with practical job preparation skills such as resume writing, interview techniques, and workplace etiquette; and
