2026 STREET DANCING COMPETITION

1. In relation to the celebration of the 13th Uhay Festival and the 25th Charter Anniversary of the Science City of Muñoz, this Office announces the conduct of the 2026 Street Dancing Competition on January 20, 2026. Part I (Street Dance) of the competition will be held during the Uhay Grand Parade, while Part II (Showdown) will follow immediately at the City Gymnasium.
2. This activity aims to:
 - a. foster creativity, fitness, enhancing teamwork and collaboration, boosting self-confidence, and providing a platform for self-expression;
 - b. provide each participating secondary school the opportunity to showcase one (1) street dance performance, evaluated using an approved division judging rubric;
 - c. recognize and reward students' excellence in street dancing by granting certificates and awards to participating schools and outstanding teams, based on the official results of the competition; and
 - d. involve learners in community service through dance activities in the community.
3. The street dancing competition is open to all public and private secondary schools in the Schools Division of Science City of Muñoz.
4. The winner of this event will represent the Schools Division of Science City of Muñoz at the Regional Festival of Talents.

5. The schoolheads of the participating schools shall assign teachers aside from coaches who will be in-charge of the safety and urgent needs of their street dancers during the competition.
6. Non-participants in the street dancing competition shall attend their usual classes while the actual participants shall be given an alternative intervention by teachers concerned.
7. Blocking and practice for the showdown competition shall be on January 19, 2026, 1:00 PM at the Pag-Asa Gymnasium.

DANCE FESTIVAL STREET DACING COMPETITION (SECONDARY)

GENERAL MECHANICS AND GUIDELINES

A. QUALIFICATIONS

1. The competition is open for all students enrolled in their respective secondary schools.
2. All entries must be composed of the following:
 - a) Dancers: 50 dancers
 - b) Propmen: Minimum of 20, maximum of 30 and should be wearing plain black pants and shirt only.

B. GENERAL RULES

1. The dance entry must be creative, interpretative and or folk based.
 - a) The dance entry has a fusion of folk and contemporary concept.
 - b) The dance entry should be based on beliefs, practices, history, legends and rituals and/or according to the other social characteristics of Science City of Munoz. Choreography, props and costumes should be inspired as to the origin of the concept. It must also incorporate agricultural products as a secondary theme for the dance.
 - c) The dance entry must not have any political undertone and should conform to the normal standards of morality.
 - d) The entry must be well thought of, well prepared and able to bring out the best of Science City of Munoz.
2. The official Uhay Festival Music (provided by the organizer) will be shared to all contingents and must be used ONLY on the last part of dance showdown choreography during the celebratory closing. For the beginning of the dance showdown, each participating school should create/ prepare their own music, using existing music that depicts the life of the countryside, specifically farmers. **Ethnic music or the like is NOT allowed to be used.**

During the entire street dance parade, the official Uhay Festival music will be used and will be provided by the organizer, where each participating school should create their own movements. Movement of the dance parade should be progressive/ continuous during the entire parade.

3. Science City of Muñoz OTOP may be featured but not necessary. Props material endemic and indigenous to the town are encouraged, however no props and costumes that are harmful to the environment and animals are allowed.
Props/ sets are NOT allowed during the street dance parade.
4. Creative inputs or elements such as that of melodies are allowed as long as the theme depicted is clearly evident in the entire presentation.
5. The actual performance for the showdown should not exceed 5 minutes. A minute (60 seconds) is given to each participating group for ingress and a minute (60 seconds) for egress.
A deduction of 5 points from the total score of every judge shall be deducted from whoever exceeds the given time frame.
6. Sharp objects like real knives and spears, creating a dangerous stunt, use of intoxicating fumes and pyro techniques or any related harmful object that may endanger the participants and audiences before, during and after the competition is **STRICTLY** prohibited.
7. Unsportsmanlike behavior during the entire competition as deemed by the committee will be subject to disqualification and forfeiture of prizes.
8. Judging shall be done on a ranking method. The group obtaining the lowest average in the rank gets the top spot.
9. The decision of the judges is binding, final, and unappealable.


