**DIVISION TRAINING OF TEACHERS ON THE REVISED
GRADES 6, 9, AND 10 CURRICULUM**

1. In support to the Department of Education's commitment to the implementation of the Revised MATATAG Curriculum, this Office through the School Governance and Operations Division (SGOD), shall conduct a Division Training of Teachers on the Revised Grades 6, 9, and 10 Curriculum on May 19-22, 2026 for Grade 6 teachers and June 2-5, 2026 for Grades 9 and 10 teachers at Muñoz National High School (MNHS) – Annex.
2. This training aims to:
 - a. familiarize teachers with the key features, structure, and standards of the revised Grades 6, 9, and 10 Curriculum;
 - b. deepen teachers' understanding of the content and performance standards across learning areas; and
 - c. ensure teachers' readiness in implementing the revised curriculum.

Meals of the participants shall be charged against the Training Expenses Fund for the Revised Curriculum Training while travel expenses shall be charged against the School Maintenance and Other Operating Expenses (MOOE) or other local funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
7. Participants shall be entitled to vacation service credits in accordance with DepEd Order No. 013, s. 2024 “Revised Guidelines on the Grant of Vacation Service Credit for Teachers”.
8. This Memorandum shall serve as the Authority to Travel for the participants.

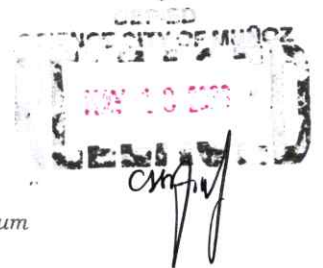
