SCHOOLS DISASTER PREPAREDNESS ACTIVITIES FOR SCHOOL YEAR 2026-2027

To: Assistant Schools Division Superintendent
Chief Education Supervisors
Public Elementary and Secondary Schoolheads

1. Relative to DepEd Order No. 9, s. 2026, titled Guidelines on the Implementation of the Three-Term School Calendar in Basic Education, this Office announces the conduct of Disaster Preparedness Activities for School Year (SY) 2026-2027. All school heads are directed to strategically schedule the conduct of the following activities after class hours:

- a. Student-Led School Watching and Hazard Mapping. DepEd Order No. 23, s. 2025 stipulates that all public schools shall conduct this activity within the first month of the school year. This initiative aims to engage learners in identifying and addressing hazards and risks within their school environment.
b. Promoting Earthquake Family Preparedness. In accordance with DepEd Order No. 27, s. 2015, all public schools shall implement activities related to the development and implementation of an Earthquake Preparedness Plan.
c. School-Based Disaster Preparedness and Response Measures for Tropical Cyclones, Flooding, and Other Weather-Related Disturbances and Calamities. As provided in DepEd Order No. 33, s. 2021, all schools shall update their Student-Family Reunification Plan as part of their school-based disaster preparedness measures. This aims to ensure the safe, structured, and lawful handover of learners to their parents or authorized guardians during emergencies, disasters, or class suspensions.

2. Attached are the guidelines for each activity.

3. Immediate and wide dissemination of this Memorandum is desired.

GUIDELINES FOR THE CONDUCT OF DISASTER PREPAREDNESS ACTIVITIES

Student-Led School Watching and Hazard Mapping

1. The activity must be conducted during the first month of the school year.
2. A moderator-facilitator shall guide the School Watching Team (composed of at least 10 members) for the activity.
3. The step-by-step process is listed under DO 23, s. 2015.
4. The output of the activity is a Hazard Map which should be presented to the School Planning Team. It must be reproduced and posted to the different areas of the school, preferably all buildings.
5. The schools should upload an Activity Completion Report (ACR) through the link <https://tinyurl.com/SY2627HazardMapping> until July 17, 2026. The parts of the ACR should include the narrative, documentation of findings, photo documentation, accomplished checklist, attendance of the participants, and hazard map.

Earthquake Family Preparedness

1. All learners shall accomplish the Earthquake Family Preparedness Homework (please refer to DO 27, s. 2015) for the template.
2. The accomplished form shall be tabulated and summarized for presentation to the Parents-Teachers Association (PTA) and barangay officials for consideration in the school and community preparedness training.
3. The tabulated result shall also be uploaded through the link <https://tinyurl.com/SY2627FamReunification> until July 24, 2026.

Student-Family Reunification Plan

1. All schools shall accomplish the Student-Family Reunification Plan.
2. The accomplished form shall be uploaded through the link <https://tinyurl.com/SY2627EQFamPrep> until July 31, 2026.
3. The Plan should include a narrative on how the students will be released during emergencies, disasters, or class suspensions.
