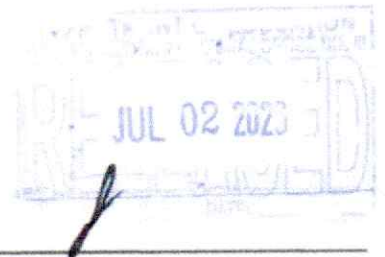

The competition will be held in two rounds: the **Provincial Round on August 15, 2026**, and the **Regional Finals on September 2, 2026**, at Vista Mall in the City of San Fernando, Pampanga. 2. Time limits for each question will vary based on difficulty.
3. Participants must write their answers on the board provided.
4. Misspelled and/or incomplete answers will be marked incorrect.
5. The top three (3) schools with the highest total scores after 30 questions will be declared as winners and qualify for the Regional Round.
6. In case of a tie:
 - Three (3) tiebreaker questions (1 point each) will be asked.
 - If the tie persists, a sudden-death question will determine the winner.
7. Only registered coaches may raise clarifications to the judges immediately after a question has been raised and answered.
8. The judges' decision is final and irrevocable.

REGIONAL FINALS

1. The final mechanics for the Regional finals will be announced after the Provincial Rounds.
2. Transportation, accommodation and meals of the participants and coaches of the regional qualifiers will be shouldered by the PSHS-CLC.
